27%, 47.1%, and 25.9% of the B.Ed II year students have very good, good and average level in their feedback in the dimension Infrastructure & Utilisation respectively




Figure :1 Feedback of B.Ed. II year Students

Figure :1.1 Feedback of B.Ed. II year Students on Teaching & Teachers







Figure :1.2 Feedback of B.Ed. II year Students on Intensive Teaching Practice

Figure :1.4 Feedback of B.Ed. II year Students on Computer Course








Figure :1.5 Feedback of B.Ed. II year Students on Activities with Communities & Guidance

Report Based on Analysis

Students' reaction form was collected at the end of two year B.Ed. Programme to make essential modifications. Feedback form consisted of seven dimensions namely Teaching and Teachers, Intensive Teaching Practice, Library Utilization of Technological gadgets, activities with communities and guidance, institutional management and communication and infrastructure and utilization.

All the above dimensions undergone three-point rating scale such as Very Good, Good and Average. The students were asked to respond within above three point scale. After collecting the responses from the respondents have undergone analysis. The collected data manually analysed and the following inferences are made.

Among 141 respondents, majority of the respondents have rated very good Teaching and Teacher, IntensiveTeaching Practice, library resources, few respondents rated as good utilization of technological gadgets, infrastructure and utilization, institutional management and communication, activities with communities and guidance and some students have rated as average.

Apart from the seven dimensions, specifications from the respondents have collected. Out of 141 respondents, 54 respondents have specified what they perceived.

- 1. Liked the college very much because of family atmosphere.
- 2. Always tobacco free and ragging free campus.
- 3. Eco friendly campus with more plants and trees.
- 4. Provisions and caring are very good.
- 5. Teaching and non teaching staff are kind-hearted.
- 6. Inspirable Teachers with conducive climate of the college leads to healthy learning.
- 7. Majority of the students have specified, not to show partiality between regular and additional intake as well as during selection of the programme.
- 8. It's place for freedom of thought and idea to be exhibited.
- 9. Discipline followed in the college is good.
- 10. Caring special category students, pregnant woman and ill health woman were appreciable.

11. Remedial coaching helped to achieve more for the weak students.

Feedback from M.Ed. students was also collected. They suggested that the course developed our knowledge in educational research, psychology, curriculum development and technology. Gathered knowledge from practical experiences in field visit of educational institutions, internship in teacher education institutions and research colloquium and discussions. Realised the need of learner centered learning.

Feedback about **computer courses** on Ms Office, Internet and its Applications(Level 1) and Multimedia and its Applications for the academic year 2017-2018 was collected from students based on Coverage of the syllabus, Organisation of the course, emphasis on fundamental concepts, study materials provided, level of interaction of teacher, availability of computer and time spent for practical classes. More than 86% of their responses identified on very good and good category. They appreciated the way of teaching and guidance given by the instructor. They suggested that they can use this learning for their professional enrichment.

Teacher Eligibility Test Coaching Class was conducted for the second year B.Ed. student. The classes began on 01.03.2018. The Guidance, Encouragement and Motivation given by the Teacher Educators was very effective. The reference books suggested by the Teacher Educators was satisfactory. Students clarified their doubts regard TET. They requested to continue TET coaching classes.
